**WHEREAS**, the City of Branson and Table Rock Lake were impacted by a tragic boating incident on July 19, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, in the most trying times of disaster, grief, and loss, Missourians and American citizens have come together to provide support, strength, and assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, several guests of a local attraction lost their lives and survivors are mourning the loss of loved ones; and

**WHEREAS**, Table Rock Lake and its surrounding communities have received an outpouring of support throughout Missouri and across the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, all individuals are invited to pause and remember their neighbors and draw upon the resources of their faith in support of those who have been affected by this tragedy.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, as a sign of solemn respect for the families and communities impacted by the boating incident, proclaim July 20- 27, 2018, as a

**STATE WEEK OF PRAYER AND REMEMBRANCE**

and do hereby order the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Missouri be flown at half-staff at all government buildings statewide until sunset, July 27, 2018, to honor the victims of the boating incident at Table Rock Lake in Stone County.
