

CONQUERING COVID-19 Keeping Missourians Safe

In April, Governor Parson announced the Show Me Strong Recovery Plan to help Missouri safely and gradually move into the recovery phase of COVID-19. Deliberate and data-driven, the plan rests on four essential pillars – testing, PPE, health care system capacity, and data. Governor Parson, his administration, and Missouri's 16 executive agencies remain committed to meeting the four pillars while protecting Missourians and driving recovery across the state.

- Administered over 2.4 million
 COVID-19 tests across Missouri
- Executed a plan to rapidly increase COVID-19 testing through box-in, sentinel, and community testing
- Allocated over \$1.2 million for comprehensive testing in long-term care facilities
- Supported implementation of the "box-in" testing strategy in 708 long term care facilities and assisted with more than 265,000 tests
- Developed an application process for schools to receive a portion of 1.84 million rapid antigen tests

- Acquired four Fluidigm testing machines developed by Washington University to be distributed regionally
- Completed mass testing of offenders and staff in all state correctional facilities, testing more than 34,000 individuals
- Partnered with more than half of Missouri's 114 counties to host free drive-through community testing events
- Worked with health care providers to set up more than 200 testing locations throughout the state
- Worked with more than 30 laboratories in processing COVID-19 tests for Missourians
