

## State of Missouri Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, Missouri believes in clean, affordable, and readily abundant forms of energy for all; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is a crucial piece of America's energy future; and

WHEREAS, Missouri currently has more than 55,000 clean renewable energy jobs; and

WHEREAS, renewable energy is the third largest employer in Missouri with 5,251 workers; and

WHEREAS, Missouri's only nuclear power plant, Callaway Nuclear Generating Station, contributed nearly 11% of the state's electricity net generation in 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, Missouri has the third-largest biodiesel production capacity in the nation: 253 million gallons annually at eight biodiesel plants.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim September 20-24, 2021, to be

in Missouri.
