**WHEREAS**, family involvement in a child's education has positive and lasting benefits for the child and the entire family; and

**WHEREAS**, House Bill 2213 was signed into law in 2008 to designate the second week in September annually as Parent and Family Involvement in Education Week; and

**WHEREAS**, Parent and Family Involvement in Education Week recognizes that parent and family involvement in a child's education is an important factor in determining success in school, regardless of status, race, ethnic background, or education level of the parents.
