

State of Missouri Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, the production, processing and distribution of dairy products creates over 22,250 jobs for Missourians; and

WHEREAS, the value of Missouri's milk production is more than \$247 million; and

WHEREAS, Missouri's dairy industry generates \$2.2 billion in value-added contribution to the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, dairy products are a source of calcium, protein, and other nutrients that are essential to a healthy diet; and

WHEREAS, organizations such as Missouri Dairy, Midwest Dairy Association, Southwest Dairy Farmers, St. Louis District Dairy Council, and the Missouri Dairy Products Association work to educate key leaders, students, and consumers about the benefits of dairy products and advance the dairy industry in Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim June 2023, to be

DAIRY MONTH

in Missouri, and encourage all residents to recognize dairy producers and the dairy industry for their contributions to the nutritional well-being of all people.
