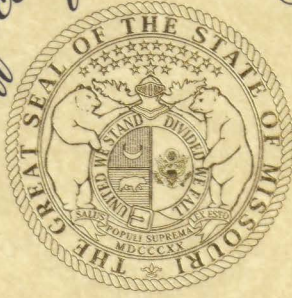

Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, propane has been helping Americans meet their energy needs for more than 100 years;
and

WHEREAS, propane plays a key role in keeping our economy moving forward, our citizens healthy,
our factories productive and our fleets running; and

WHEREAS, America is the world's leading propane producer which supports national energy security,
reliability, and resilience; and

WHEREAS, propane helps consumers meet their heating and energy needs as a reliable, secure and
efficient fuel; and

WHEREAS, propane contributes directly to decarbonization of our environment by replacing more
carbon-intense fuels; and

WHEREAS, Missouri's propane industry employs more than 1,000 workers and contributes \$1.8
billion to the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, October 7, 2023, has been declared National Propane Day to recognize the industry's
significant national contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do
hereby proclaim October 7, 2023, to be

PROPANE DAY

in Missouri.
