WHEREAS, the family is the primary source of love, identity, self-esteem and support for children and adults, and provides the foundation of our communities; and

WHEREAS, the bond between child and parents and family members provides the nurturing and security that is critical for personal growth and development; and

WHEREAS, parents can encounter problems that require attention and assistance to ensure the safety and caring support of their children and their family; and

WHEREAS, because of this important bond, reunification with parents and family is the best option and preferred outcome for children removed from their homes and placed in foster care; and

WHEREAS, safe reunification takes work, commitment, and investment of time and resources by parents, family members, social workers, foster parents, service providers, attorneys, courts, and the community; and

WHEREAS, June is celebrated as National Reunification Month to recognize and honor the parents who have done the hard work necessary to safely reunite with their children and the people, programs, services, and supports that helped them.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim June 2024 to be

FAMILY REUNIFICATION MONTH

in Missouri.
