WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Dominic E. Schraft, of Vienna, Missouri, was a member of the United States Marine Corps, assigned to Battery R, 5th Battalion, 11th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, Camp Pendleton, California; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2015, Lance Corporal Schraft, age 19, died at Camp Pendleton while serving his country; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Schraft's awards and decorations include the National Defense Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal.



LANCE CORPORAL DOMINIC E. SCHRAFT


