



### **Social Media Moderation Policy**

The Office of the Governor considers its social media platforms to be moderated online discussion sites. As a result, comments and posts that violate any of the guidelines listed below may be removed without notice:

- Profane language or content;
- Content that promotes, fosters or perpetuates discrimination against protected classes;
- Advertisements, prize contests or giveaways. This includes promotion or endorsement of any financial, commercial or non-governmental agency;
- Apparent spamming or trolling, including comments with links to external online sites;
- Copyrighted or trademarked images or graphics. Imagery posted should be owned by the user; and
- Comments, photos or videos that suggest or encourage illegal activity.

Continued violations of any portion of this policy may result in the restriction of the individual's right to comment on the official Governor's Office social media platform(s).
